

**Fluvanna County, Virginia  
Economic Development Commission and  
Economic Development Authority**

**Joint Resolution Adopted June 8, 2010**

WHEREAS, The Comprehensive Plan adopted by the Board of Supervisors on March 18, 2009, specifically addresses the topic of Economic Development in Chapter 6. In that chapter, the Board of Supervisors identified certain goals and strategies to be implemented in order to achieve the County's vision, and

WHEREAS, Goal 2 of the Comprehensive Plan specifically states that a portion of the Zion Crossroads community planning area will be designated as the County's Urban Development Area, and

WHEREAS, Goal 2 further states that the County will construct a water line to the Urban Development area, along with necessary waste treatment facilities, broadband and cellular services and road improvements to provide the necessary infrastructure, and

WHEREAS, in a concerted effort to comply with the Comprehensive Plan and the Board of Supervisors' direction, the Economic Development Commission has dedicated its time and resources to developing a Business Plan that will enable implementation of those goals and strategies, and

WHEREAS, the Economic Development Commission and the Economic Development Authority of Fluvanna County wish to communicate to the Board of Supervisors their continuing advocacy for the necessary infrastructure to facilitate economic development at Zion Crossroads.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Economic Development Commission and the Economic Development Authority of Fluvanna County, Virginia, unanimously agree that supplying water to the Zion Crossroads area is imperative for economic development. We further encourage all citizens of Fluvanna County to attend the Town Hall meeting to be hosted by the Citizens Water Committee on June 21, 2010, at 7:00 p.m. in the Fluvanna County Community Center, 5725 James Madison Highway, Fork Union, Virginia.
